

Information on REACH regulation

Dear Sir or Madam,

since June 1, 2007 the EC regulation No 1907/2006 about the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals ("REACH") is in force.

Intermas-Elcom manufactures "articles" (cabinets, housings, subracks, accessories as well as integrated complete solutions and electronic systems). According to article 33 of the REACH regulation, we have to inform our customers if one of our supplied parts contains substances of very high concern (SVHC) with a concentration above 0.1 percent by weight of the product.

The candidate list of SVHC is subject of periodic updates, last on 14. June 2023, it now contains 235 different substances. The list is published on the web site of the European Chemicals Agency: http://echa.europa.eu/chem_data/authorisation_process/candidate_list_table_en.asp

Since 27. June 2018 lead was included (CAS 7439-92-1) in the SVHC list, for its toxicity for reproduction. Lead is used as alloying addition for copper and steel materials, to improve the machinability. Lead is used in some of our articles in exemptions which are described in the RoHS directive.

In some of our plastic guide components for Interface-Housings the material Makrolon® 6555 is used. This contains the substance potassium perfluorobutanesulfonate (CAS 29420-49-3). We are working on eliminating these substances from our products.

In our own interest and to provide a high supply and product safety, we take this information duty very serious. As soon as we gain knowledge of an SVHC >0.1% in one of our products, we will inform in our offer, order confirmation and delivery note.

We also do not use any substances from annex XVII in the restricted conditions.
